The mission of The Interfaith Alliance of Colorado (TIA-CO) is to advance the common good through the creation of a civil society that respects the differences and honors the commonalities of all faith communities and people of good will.

We are an interfaith, member-driven, grassroots organization that:

- responds proactively to **strengthen democracy** in our culture;
- serves as a **progressive voice** of reason, moderation and mutual respect for communities of faith; and
- promotes **religious freedom**, understanding and diversity.



We work to mobilize people of faith, to educate and lobby decision makers, and to provide resources for greater understanding and mutual respect where religion and government intersect.

How do we make a difference?

- We took action to **restore state funding** for programs serving people in need by forming and leading the **Colorado Religious Coalition for the Common Good**, which was integral to the successful passage of **Referendum C** in 2005.
- We supported a crime bill to designate violence based on sexual orientation as a "bias-motivated crime." We believe that **no society can afford to let hate go unchallenged.**



- We bring together small groups of friends and neighbors to take action on the issues closest to their hearts. **Meetup TIA-CO** groups
